### BEST BREAKFASTS IN TOWN

For your Saturday breakfast, visit the ever-popular Naplavka Farmers' Market, by the river under Vysehrad fortress, for great coffee, pastries and cheese, and a view that will ensure you fall in love with the city. Just plan to get there early!

### LUNCH IN SPLENDOUR

The Café Savoy boasts a stunning Art Nouveau interior with magnificent chandeliers and large windows overlooking the street. It's the perfect spot for relaxing over a light lunch or taking a break from sightseeing, with a coffee and pastry.

### A MEDIEVAL BANQUET

Be transported back to the Middle Ages at this atmospheric restaurant with a difference. Book in advance for an evening at the medieval tavern of U Pavouka, and enjoy a hearty and traditional meal, with entertainment from jugglers, belly-dancers and musicians.



## A SIGHT TO BEHOLD

### SOAK UP THE ATMOSPHERE

A delightful way to watch Prague wake up is over a coffee at one of the cafés near the Spanish synagogue, before taking a look inside this incredible Moorish-style building, inspired by the Alhambra Palace.

### MUSIC MAESTRO, PLEASE!

In 1787 Mozart conducted his Don Giovanni when it premiered at the Estates Theatre, and two centuries later the building starred in Milos Forman's Oscar-winning Amadeus. Book tickets for a Mozart opera there and let your imagination do the rest.

### TIME TO STOP AND WONDER

Make sure you see (and hear!) the jewel of Prague's Old Town Square - the world famous Astronomical Clock - in action, and take the time to climb up the Old Town Hall Tower for one of the best views of the city.



## A PARTING GIFT

### PRAGUE'S OLDEST MARKET

Get there early to soak up the atmosphere at Havel'ský Market. Dating back to 1232, it's Prague's oldest open-air market and offers fresh fruit, vegetables, sweets and souvenirs. Look out for fresh honey, and, in the run up to Easter, colourful painted eggs.

### THE ART OF PUPPETRY

For an unusual gift or souvenir, the Puppet Shop is a fascinating, authentic store selling hand-carved marionettes, a traditional art that dates back to the 18th century. Many of these beautiful, elaborately carved puppets are real works of art.

### BEWITCHING JEWELS
