A LONG, LAZY LUNCH

URBAN DINING

If you prefer an elegant and contemporary dining experience, Messa, one of Condé Nast Traveller's 80 Hot Tables, combines striking Middle Eastern flavours with Provençal cooking techniques. Try the semifreddo brûlée – delicious.

STUNNING SUNSETS

At the end of the seaside promenade is Namal Tel Aviv, the recently restored Tel Aviv Port. Take your pick of beautiful waterside cafès and restaurants, relax and drink in the view, especially at sundown. Then prepare to party – it's one of the city's favourite nightspots.

HIDDEN GEMS

Tucked away, but just a short walk from your hotel, is Neve Tzedek, a quaint and historic area with narrow streets which constantly throw up new surprises. At its heart, dance lovers will find the Suzanne Dellal Center well worth a visit.

AN ARTISTIC ADVENTURE

The streets of Tel Aviv offer a magnificent gallery of street art and graffiti, particularly in the Florentin neighbourhood. You'll spot plenty of it on a casual wander, but to discover some of the less obvious masterpieces, take a guided tour.
