A SIGHT TO BEHOLD

UNEXPECTED OPULENCE

Some of the Moscow Metro stations are worth a visit in their own right. Komsomolskaya is one of the most famous, and from the outside looks like a cross between a palace and a cathedral. Inside you'll find flamboyant ornaments, enormous chandeliers, and eight ceiling mosaics depicting Russia's fight for freedom.

MOSCOW BY BOAT

Red Square, of course, is the No 1 on any Moscow visitor's to-do list. But if you've got enough time to spare, a boat trip is a lovely way to see the Kremlin, St Basil's and the city's other highlights. Join a shuttle near Kievskaya metro station and hop on and off to explore at your leisure.

RUSSIA'S SPIRITUAL HEART

Danilov Monastery is a jewel of Russian Medieval architecture dating from the 13th century, which, during its chequered history, has served the city as fortress, archive and even prison. These days it's the spiritual centre of the Russian Orthodox Church, and official home to the Patriarch.



A PARTING GIFT

HISTORIC SOUVENIRS

Round off a visit to the State Central Museum of Contemporary Russian History in the museum shop and acquire your own souvenir of the Soviet era. Beside the inevitable postcards and fridge magnets, you'll find rare artefacts like certificates, prints and bank notes.

STYLE AND HISTORY

The world-famous GUM is more than a department store, it's one of Moscow's key cultural centres, where you can find fashion shows, art and even the restored historic public toilets and showers - whose fascinating story warrants a special mention all of their own!

GASTRONOMIC DELIGHTS

Eliseevskiy Gastronom is a legend, both for its exquisitely and widely stocked delicatessen and for the extravagant early 20th century décor; huge crystal chandeliers resembling vast bunches of grapes dangle from the ornate ceiling. It truly is a gastronomic paradise.
