BREAKFAST IN THE ALPS

A perfect morning in Davos has to start with breakfast at the Alpine Brasserie Capricorn. Then follow the scenic path down from the restaurant's terrace to the natural lake, a beautiful setting for your daily walk or run.

AS CHEESY AS IT GETS

Les Armures is one of Geneva's oldest restaurants, serving traditional Swiss specialities, including the famous cheese fondue, in a charming and historic setting. The story goes that Bill Clinton first discovered fondue here. You certainly can't fault his menu choices.

FOOD WITH A VIEW

For something a little different, Le Pavillon du Lac offers excellent seasonal menus, and terrace with a panoramic view of the lake which is particularly good at sunset. You can't book the terrace, so arrive early to claim your table.

ESSENTIAL DAVOS

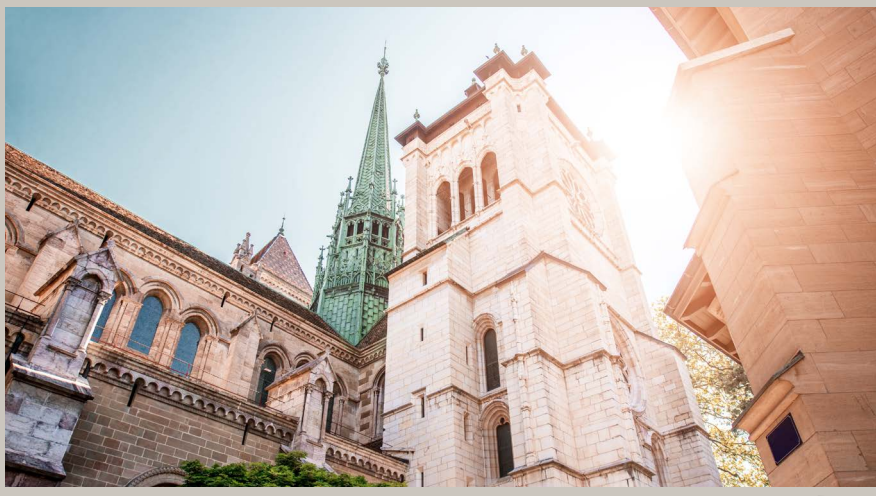
Kaffee Klatsch, with delicious coffee creations and homemade delicacies, is one of Davos' must-visits. Then take the Schatzalpbahn up to Thomas Manns 'Magic Mountain' and walk off the calories around the Alpinum.

A HIDDEN GEM

Celebrating the talent of Geneva's watchmakers, the Malbuisson Clock entertains passers-by every hour. This fairytale creation, with its procession of 42 bronze figures, was designed by Eduard Wirth to celebrate the Escalade, an important part of Geneva's history.

A LAKESIDE IDYLL

For a particularly lovely view of the lake, walk down to the Park de la Perle du Lac. Below the monumental fountain, a huge lawn slopes gently towards the water, and the restaurant terrace offers an idyllic spot for afternoon to melt into evening.



A PARTING GIFT

TIME TO SHOP

The Swiss know a thing or two about luxury timepieces. And with Geneva's history of watchmaking going back to the mid-17th century, you're in the right place to find a luxury brand or two. Start in Rue du Rhone, for Patek Philippe and Piaget.

GENEVA'S 'GREENWICH VILLAGE'

Just over 10 minutes from the city centre is the 18th century district of Carouge. By day, browse boutiques and antique stores around the Place du Marché and see the artisans at work. By night, soak up the bohemian vibe spilling from cafés, jazz bars and nightclubs.

TASTY TREATS TO TAKE HOME

The culinary boutique Bündner-Land specialises in Bündner Fleish, the traditional air-dried beef that is a famous delicacy of the Grison region. You'll also find fine local Grison wine, cheese, fondue mixes and other culinary gifts and souvenirs.
