DISCOVER THE BEAUTY OF THE POLLERA

Our "Pollera" is considered one of the most brilliant and select of all traditional costumes of the world.

The Panamanian skirt "Pollera" born from the Spanish female costume of the seventeenth century was worn as a daily outfit, usually white with a wide skirt flight with two or three bases and an overlapping or embroidery floral design.

Our national costume is a mix of the Spaniard dress from all different regions. It has become accustomed to the climate, geographical position of Panama and has evolved since the colonization period till today. The Pollera is composed of two separate parts, consisting of a shirt and a polleron made of fine cloth.

DISCOVER THE COLORFUL MOLAS MADE

BYTHE KUNA INDIANS

The mola forms part of the traditional costume of a Kuna woman, two mola panels being incorporated as the front and back panels in a blouse.

In Dulegaya, the Kuna's native language, "mola" means "shirt" or "clothing". Molas are hand made using a reverse appliqué technique. Several layers (usually two to seven) of different-colored cloth (usually cotton) are sewn together; the design is then formed by cutting away parts of each layer. The edges of the layers are then turned under and sewn down.
